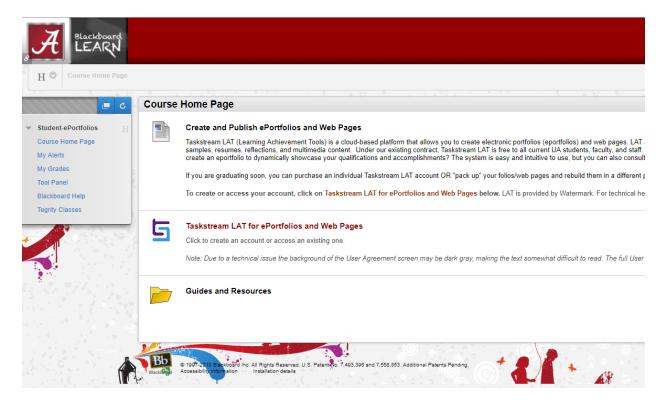
Accessing Taskstream LAT for ePortfolios

All current UA students have the opportunity to use **Taskstream LAT**, a cloud-based platform that allows users to create web pages and electronic portfolios (eportfolios). If you're getting ready to apply for a job or internship, why not create a personalized eportfolio to showcase the skills and experiences that make you a strong candidate? Or perhaps you want a dynamic way to integrate and share what you learned during study abroad, research projects, or other UA experiences. Through the Taskstream LAT platform, you can create and publish as many eportfolios as you need.

<u>To access Taskstream LAT</u>, log into **Blackboard Learn** and search for a course called **Student ePortfolios**. Self-enroll in the course, then follow the instructions to create an LAT account (or access your existing account). UA's current contract with Watermark (the company that offers Taskstream LAT) runs through 2020. During that time, it will be available at no cost to UA students, faculty, and staff.
